 2. Alterations and repair work determined by the mechanical official to be of a minor nature.
 3. Business, mercantile and storage buildings having HVAC equipment only, with one fire area and not more than 3,500 square feet.
 4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

APPLICANT SIGNATURE: Section 23a of the State Construction code Act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. General: Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for the permit has been filed. All installation shall be in conformance with the Michigan Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
